
Woman-Owned Small Business Prime Contracting FY2019

Small business is expanding and contributing to the economy at a record-breaking level. By better competing for and winning federal contracts, small businesses have supported about 677,000 jobs, driving job creation, innovation, and growth on a local, regional, and national level.



Outreach efforts

- Continues to promote certification programs; educate woman-owned small businesses on federal contracting.
- Partner with Women Impacting Public Policy and American Express on initiatives like ChallengeHER.
 - Boosts contracting opportunities for womanowned small businesses.
 - In seventh year, has educated over 21,000 women entrepreneurs.
- Hosted 70 events nationally for woman-owned small businesses and government officials.

FY2019 Highlights

- Federal government exceeded the small business contracting goal for the seventh consecutive year.
- Awarded record breaking \$132.9 billion in prime contracts to small business.
- Exceeded goal: achieved 5.19%
 (\$26 billion) of eligible contracting
 dollars: highest amount ever.
- Could equate to over **134,000 jobs**.
- Surpassed goal for second time in past seven years.
- Prime contracts awarded to 15,000
 WOSB prime contractors 21% total small business vendors.
- Average award of \$1.85 million per prime contractor.
